Dear Windham Community,

Over the past few weeks, the new schools construction project has made significant progress. The construction team has been busy clearing the land and will soon begin work on a loop access road. We are delighted with the progress that has been made to date and want to notify you of a few key updates on the project.

- We are pleased to announce that we will hold an official groundbreaking ceremony at 5pm on Wednesday, September 20 at Golden Brook School followed by a public update information session at 6pm. A rain date has been scheduled for 5pm on Wednesday, September 27. We hope that you will join us in the celebration.
- As of this week, the morning drop-off pattern at Golden Brook School has changed, cars are restricted to left lane use only and should adhere to instructions from onsite school personnel when dropping off children. In addition, over the next four weeks or so, large construction vehicles will be transporting materials to and from Golden Brook School and Windham Middle School daily between the hours of 9 and 11am as well as 12:30 and 1:30pm. These have been scheduled in order to have minimal impact on morning, afternoon and kindergarten drop-off and dismissal procedures and athletic activities. However, if you do need to visit the schools during those times, please be aware traffic may be delayed and plan accordingly.
- The safety and welfare of students, staff and the community is paramount and we are working very closely with the construction management team to ensure that the construction area is safe and secure at all times. However, if there are any concerns, please direct them to the school principals.
- We will provide ongoing updates on the construction project's progress via windhamsd.org, the district's Facebook page and monthly public meetings to be held at 6pm on the third Wednesday of the month beginning on September 20, 2017.
