- Expand their ability to communicate in Spanish (writing, oral and written comprehension)

Grade 6

The preliminary lesson will teach students to:

- Describe the weather
- Use classroom phrases

Unit 1 will get students to:

- Say what you like and do not like to do
- Describe oneself and others
- Identify people and things
- Use subject pronouns and “ser”
- Use “gustar” with infinitive
- Use Definite and indefinite articles
- Ensure noun adjective agreement

Grade 7

Unit 2 will teach students to:

- Ask and tell time
- Say what one has to do
- Say what one does and how often one does things
- Say where one is located and how one is feeling
- Say where one is going
- Use vocabulary for classes, locations, and schedules
- Use the verbs “tener”, “estar”, and “ir”
- Use present tense conjugations of -ar verbs

Unit 3 will allow students to:

- Talk about foods and beverages
- Say which foods one likes and doesn't like
- Talk about family
- Ask and tell ages
- Express possession
- Give dates
- Give comparisons
- Use “gustar” with nouns
- Use the present tense of -er and -ir verbs
- Use possessive adjectives
- Use comparatives
