

**STUDENT CONDUCT, RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

All student behavior shall be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others. Students are expected to recognize and respect the diversity of our student community.

Students are expected to behave at all times in a manner appropriate to good citizenship. This includes respectful use of language and behavior that avoids ethnic, racial, sexual, and disability-based stereotypes and biases. Insults or sarcasm shall not be directed toward other students or staff. Bullying and cyber-bullying are prohibited in accord with School Board policy JICBB.

Students' rights and responsibilities shall be published in the parent-student handbook, a copy of which shall be made available in an alternative format or other language upon request. Students are expected to know and respect the rules and regulations of the school as set forth by District policies, the parent-student handbook, and the administrators of the District. Parents and guardians have a responsibility to assist their child in reviewing and understanding the parent-student handbook. The parent-student handbook shall be provided to all students annually at the opening of school and to those students who enroll during the course of the school year. Student disciplinary procedures shall be implemented pursuant to the provisions of School Board policy JICD.
