### **SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS / TERMS / REMOVAL FROM OFFICE**

The School Board shall consist of five members elected by the qualified voters of the District at the annual District elections held in March.

Any citizen who files for and seeks election to the Board should do so with full knowledge of and appreciation for the investment in time, effort, and dedication expected of all Board members and with the intent to serve the full term of office. School board members shall make every effort to attend every scheduled meeting.

#### Qualifications

To become a candidate for any school district office, a person must be a registered voter in the district. No person holding the office of member of the school board shall at the time hold the office of district moderator, treasurer, or auditor. No person employed by the school district shall be a school board member.

#### Terms

The term of office of each member of the School Board shall be for a period of three (3) years, staggered so that no more than two school board seats are open in any given election (except in case of resignation or removal of board members).

#### Resignations

If a board member decides to resign, the Board requests the earliest possible notification of intent so that the Board may plan appropriately for a replacement. A letter of resignation should be sent to the Chairman and the District clerk.

#### Removal From Office

A board member may not be removed from office except as provided in RSA 32:12 and RSA 42:1-a.

#### Vacancies

Vacancies shall be filled in accordance with RSA 197:26 and RSA 671:33.
