

SENIOR-STUDENT SCHEDULES**Senior Course Requirements**

Students enrolled as seniors at Windham High School are required to take six (6) credits as a minimum. These six (6) credits shall consist of English and five (5) electives.

Exceptions: The School Board acknowledges that there will be cases in which the best interest of an individual student would be served by making an exception to this policy. When there is an indication that this is the case, the Principal may approve an exception based upon a request by the student supported by the parent/guardian and recommended by the Guidance Director. Each such request will be evaluated on the student's goals, accomplishments and needs, and address both the academics and non-academics.

Upon the approval of the Principal, students whose class (year of graduation) has graduated may take a course load which is sufficient to meet any credit deficiencies.

Late Arrival – Early Dismissal

When approved by the Principal, high school seniors whose school day ends with study periods may apply for Early Dismissal to be released after their last class. Such application must be signed by the parent/guardian and recommended by the Assistant Principal(s). Work release and Early Release programs will be monitored by the Guidance Counselor.

When approved by the Principal, based upon extenuating circumstances, students may be granted a late arrival if their schedule starts with a study period. Such requests must be supported by the parent/guardian and recommended by the Assistant Principal(s) and the Guidance Director.

All late arrival and early dismissal approvals are granted by the Principal on an individualized basis and take into account attendance, behavior and academic factors.
