**ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS**

(And Tuition)

No person shall attend school, or send a pupil to the school, in any district of which he/she is not an inhabitant. (RSA 193:12)

Nonresident students who have not officially relocated to Windham, NH, should remain enrolled in their previous school district until such time as they become Windham residents.

Consideration for pre-enrollment will be given when a signed Purchase & Sales Agreement is presented, that includes an anticipated occupancy date prior to the first official day of school, as set on the school district calendar in any given school year.

When a signed, fully executed rental/lease agreement for a Windham residence is presented at the time of registration, the rental/lease agreement must include a beginning rental date prior to the first day of school for consideration for pre-enrollment for an upcoming school year. If the rental/lease agreement occurs during a school year, the occupancy date, stated in the rental/lease agreement, must coincide with the enrollment date requested. The Registrar will request an updated rental/lease agreement at the end of the stated rental agreement period.

Under special circumstances, when a sending district is responsible for tuition, approval must be received from the sending districts' school board. If tuition approval is granted from a sending districts' school board then the Windham School Board may consider enrollment depending on class size availability. Tuition based enrollment will be reviewed on an annual basis.
